During the month of May we are piloting our updated Promoting Positive Behaviour guidance. The guidance focuses on rewarding the excellent behaviour of our pupils and ensuring consistent standards and expectations are shared across the school.

Assemblies have been held with all pupils to share expectations for the next four weeks.

We will consult with parents and pupils at the end of the pilot.



The Focus





The Promoting Positive Behaviour guidance focuses on our three school values:

- Responsible
- Resilient
- Respectful

Each term we will focus on one of the values, beginning with being Responsible.

Be Responsible



We are asking pupils to focus on three rules:

- On time
- Be ready
- Electronics away

May pilot





On time: Be on time to class

If pupils are late for class without a valid explanation they will be issued with a demerit

Be ready: Be ready to learn

All equipment should be ready so pupils can start the lesson. If pupils need stationery, PE kit or specialist equipment they should ask at the start of the lesson and they will be provided with what they need.

If you do not ask at the start of the lesson, before teaching starts, they will be issued with a demerit.

Electronics away: Electronics should only be used in class when directed by the teacher. If pupils have their device out in class without permission they will be issued with a demerit.

Demerits will continue to be issued for uniform issues and late/incomplete homework.

The Merit System



All pupils will start with 100 merits.

All pupils who retain 90% of merits will take part in a masterclass afternoon of activity in school in June.

Pupils who do not retain merits will be interviewed by faculty heads or senior management and next steps discussed.
