Senior Phase Winter Assessments

Our National 5 winter assessments start on Thursday, 7 December 2023 and take place over a two-week period. Our Winter Assessment Diet is important in preparing pupils for their final SQA exams by providing an opportunity to sit assessments under SQA exam conditions. These assessments will provide young people with an understanding of their progress to date, allowing them to set targets, identify areas of strength and focus on areas for further study. More detailed information on these assessments will be issued to pupils during November.

Online Platforms

Many of the Google Classrooms from S3 will continue into S4. However, pupils should ensure that they have joined any new S4 Google Classroom pages, if required. Every S4 pupil should also be a member of the year group information Google Classroom. We share important information and opportunities on this page throughout the year and therefore pupils should check regularly for updates.

We are currently working on the launch of a homework tracking app for all parents/carers and pupils to use as an online homework tool. Further information will be shared over the coming weeks.

Parentsportal.scot is a new digital service to help replace the traditional 'school bag run' by providing direct communication to parents and carers through a growing suite of online services. I would encourage all parents/carers to access this service to help us improve our communication with home.

Support with Career Planning

Pupils in our Senior Phase will be encouraged by our guidance team and Skills Development Scotland to research and plan for future study and careers. Any pupil in S4 who is considering leaving school at the end of this academic session should ensure their guidance teacher is aware of their intention. We will then ensure each young person is fully supported to develop the experiences and skills required to make a successful transition.
