What is Glow?

Glow is Scotland's online learning hub - think of it as your digital school bag!

Every pupil gets their own login to access all the tools they need.

What you get:

- Microsoft Office (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Teams, email)
- Access to Google Classroom, Satchel One and Achieve
- Cloud storage so you can access your work

Getting in:

Go to glow.rmunify.com
Use your school username and password
Click the tiles to open different apps

What is Google Classroom?

This is where your teachers post classwork, homework, and announcements. Think of it as your online classroom.

Teachers use it to:

Share lesson materials and homework Make announcements Give feedback on your work

Pupils can:

See and complete assignments Submit work online Get grades and feedback Ask questions

Getting there:

Log into Glow Click the Google Classroom tile Pick your class

Satchel One

What is Satchel One?

Satchel One is the app that helps parents and pupils keep track of homework and assignments.

It links directly to Google Classroom.

Parent's and Carers can:

Go to Satchel One or download the app

Log in using your parent account (ask school for login details if needed)

Check the dashboard regularly to keep track of homework

How to help

Getting started:

- Ask your child to show you around the platforms
- Bookmark the sites on your devices
- Make sure they can log in from home

Staying in the loop

- Check Google Classroom's 'Classwork' tab for assignments
- Satchel One will notify you about homework (not everything on there is homework!*)
- Help keep track of deadlines

Satchel One doesn't distinguish between work being posted as classwork and work being posted as homework.

It will usually be made clear in the title

When Things Go Wrony

Forgotten password or username

- Forgotten password or username?
- Ask your teacher they'll sort it quickly
- Make sure you're using your @glow.sch.uk email address

Can't find your google classroom?

Ask your teacher, you might need to accept an invitation.

Glow wont load?

Make sure you're using Chrome or Edge browsers.

Stay Safe Online

- Keep your login details to yourself (don't share with friends!)
- Always log out on shared computers
- Tell a teacher if you see anything inappropriate
- Store passwords somewhere safe
